Competition Brief

Competition Title

Child Care

Competition Overview

A child care assistant is typically involved with the physical care of children. With infants, this involves feeding, changing, holding and comforting them. For toddlers, this may include toilet training and assisting with personal hygiene, like washing hands. They are also involved in supporting children's holistic development.

The competition will comprise four activities over 2 hours 20 minutes, based on child development and learning through play.

Live competition heats will be held at various venues across Wales.

Entry Criteria

The competition is for those training for a career in Childcare and studying towards a Level 3 qualification. Please ensure your entrants have the skills and competencies to complete the task.

Entry capacity restrictions by organisation

Maximum of up to 2 per location plus maximum of 2 reserves can be registered incase of absence.

This is the maximum number of entries permitted by an organisation for this competition. This is determined by 'location' and 'organisation'. 'Organisation' refers to the competitors' training provider/employer. 'Location' refers to a site where the competitor studies / is employed.

This competition may be subject to a selection process if competitor registration numbers exceed the host venue capacity. Where capacity is identified in a competition the reserve competitors may be invited to compete.

The decision will be made following a consultation between Skills Competition Wales and the competition lead after registration closes. All parties will be notified of any changes.

Brief

Competitors will have a 10 minute introduction to the environment to ask questions; then a further 2 hours and 20 minutes to complete all four activities which should include dimensions of Equality, Diversity and Welsh Language.

Activity 1: Bathing a Baby

Individual task: up to 30 minutes

You have started a new job working with a health visitor. Following [NHS guidelines](#), demonstrate and inform a new parent how to prepare a bath and a baby for bathing. Bathe, dry and dress appropriately. A choice of equipment will be provided for you. It is important that candidates demonstrate a rapport with the baby as communication skills will be judged.

You will be required to:

- Set up and prepare the bath for bathing
- Prepare the baby for the bath
- Bathe the baby ensuring safety and care of the baby at all times
- Dress the baby appropriately post bath
- Clean away equipment post bath

You will be judged on your interaction with the baby, health & safety and the setting up and clearing away of equipment.

Activity 2: Complete an Activity Plan

Please note, an element of this activity is to be completed in advance of the competition day as specified below.

Pre-competition day activity

You are a childcare worker who has been given the task of creating a range of props to use with children, aged 3-5 years, during storytelling sessions.

The theme of the task is a children's picture book (the book you will read in activity 3).

The props should help develop the children's literacy or numeracy skills and should be completed BEFORE the event.

You will need to bring the props with you on the day of competition.

You must bring photographs as evidence to show the preparation of the props that are to be used in Activity 3.

On the day of competition

You will be provided with up to 30 minutes to complete this task (30 minutes activity planning)

You will need to complete the activity plan provided and explain your activity plan to the judges.

Candidates will need to bring photographs as evidence to show the preparation of the props used in Activity 3.

Judging will include appropriateness of the resources you made, health & safety and your planning for cross curricula development links to areas of learning within the current curriculum.

Activity 3: Reading a story

Individual task: up to 20 minutes

You have been asked to read *The very hungry caterpillar* by Eric Carle ISBN -10-0140569324 during story time to a ‘small group of children’. The book is suitable for children aged 3-5 years.

You will be expected to create storytelling props and bring them along with you on the day (see activity 2). Books will be available in Welsh and English

Judging will include your introduction and ending of the book, tone, pace, interaction with ‘children’ and questioning as well as your use of the storytelling props you have created. If you are not reading through Welsh Medium then you will be expected to use some incidental Welsh when telling your story.

Activity 4: Plan, design and create a small world play area for children aged 3-5 years to develop their skills across the curricula.

Individual task: up to 1 hr.

You are a childcare practitioner who has been given the task of planning a school trip to a farm. In preparation for this trip, you are required to plan, design and create a small world play area based on the theme “The Farm”. The activity must develop the children’s skills across the curricula. The small world play area is to be designed for children aged three to

five years and you will be able to choose from the resources supplied. You will need to create the small world play area and then verbally summarise and outline to the judges how this small world session is intended to prepare the children for the trip.

Judging will be based upon creativity, age appropriateness, developmental opportunities and links to areas of learning. To be completed on the attached evaluation sheet on the day of competition.

Competition Rules

Competition specific rules

- Dress should be professional and adhere to relevant professional standards. Attire must be non-branded (i.e. no college/employer logos visible).
- All activities must be completed by competitors within the allotted time.

Generic competition rules

- Mobile phones are to be switched off during competition activity.
- Listening to music via headphones is not permitted during competition activity.
- Any questions during competition activity should be addressed to the competition judging panel.
- Competitors should not communicate with other competitors during competition activity.
- It is the responsibility of each competitor to arrive on time for each competition session. No additional time will be allowed if you arrive late.
- Technical failure of your equipment should be reported immediately to the judging panel. Additional time will be allocated if the fault is beyond the control of the competitor.

Marking and Assessment

Marking and judging of this competition will be done by a team of experts from Industry, Further Education or Training Provider, using a marking criteria and allocated marks to ensure consistency.

Activity 3 Reading a story.	Introduction and ending of the book, tone, pace, interaction with children and questioning. Use of storytelling props and welsh language.	20%
Activity 4 Small world area.	Creativity, age appropriateness, developmental opportunities and links to areas of learning. Completion of evaluation sheet on the day of competition.	40%

Mae cynorthwyydd gofal plant fel arfer yn ymwneud â gofal corfforol plant. Gyda babanod, mae hyn yn golygu eu bwydo, eu newid, eu dal a'u cysuro. Ar gyfer plant bach, gall hyn gynnwys eu dysgu i fynd i'r tŷ bach a chynorthwyo gyda hylendid personol, fel golchi dwylo. Maent hefyd yn ymwneud â chefnogi datblygiad cyfannol plant.

Bydd y gystadleuaeth yn cynnwys pedwar gweithgaredd dros 2 awr 20 munud, yn seiliedig ar ddatblygiad plant a dysgu drwy chwarae.

Gweithgaredd 1: Rhoi Bath i Fabi

Tasg unigol: hyd at 30 munud

Gan ddilyn [canllawiau'r GIG](#), dangoswch a hysbyswch i riant newydd sut i baratoi babi ar gyfer ymolchi, ymolchi'r babi a'i sychu a'i wisgo'n briodol. Bydd dewis o offer ar gael i chi. Gofynnwyd i chi ddarllen Y Lindysyn Llwglyd lawn gan Eric Carle ISBN -10-0140569324 i grŵp bach o blant. Bydd y llyfr yn addas ar gyfer plant 3-5 oed. Bydd disgwyl i chi greu propiau adrodd straeon a dod â nhw gyda chi ar y diwrnod (gweler gweithgaredd 2). Bydd y llyfrau ar gael yn Gymraeg ac yn Saesneg

Bydd y beirniadu yn cynnwys eich cyflwyniad a diwedd y llyfr, eich tōn, cyflymder, y rhyngweithio â'r 'phlant' a chwestiynu yn ogystal â'ch defnydd o'r propiau adrodd straeon rydych chi wedi'u creu. Os nad ydych yn darllen drwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg yna bydd disgwyl i chi ddefnyddio rhywfaint o Gymraeg achlysurol wrth adrodd eich stori.

Gweithgaredd 4:Cynllun, dylunio a chreu ardal chwarae byd bach i blant 3-5 oed i ddatblygu eu sgiliau ar draws y cwricwla.

Tasg unigol: hyd at 1 awr.

Rydych chi'n ymarferydd gofal plant sydd wedi cael y dasg o gynllunio taith ysgol i fferm. Wrth baratoi ar gyfer y daith hon, mae angen i chi gynllunio, dylunio a chreu ardal chwarae byd bach yn seiliedig ar y thema "Y Fferm". Rhaid i'r gweithgaredd ddatblygu sgiliau'r plant ar draws y cwricwlwm. Mae'r ardal chwarae byd bach wedi'i chynllunio ar gyfer plant rhwng tair a phum mlwydd oed a byddwch chi'n gallu dewis o'r adnoddau sy'n cael eu darparu. Bydd angen i chi greu'r ardal chwarae byd bach ac yna crynhoi ar lafar ac amlinellu i'r beirniaid sut

y bwriedir i'r sesiwn byd bach hwn barato'i'r plant ar gyfer y daith.

Bydd y beirniadu yn seiliedig ar greadigrwydd, addasrwydd oedran, cyfleoedd datblygu a chysylltiadau â meysydd dysgu. I'w gwblhau ar y daflen werthuso atodedig ar ddiwrnod y gystadleuaeth.
