## **Competition Brief**

### **Competition Title**

Inclusive Skills: Childcare

### **Competition Overview**

A child care assistant is typically involved with the physical care of children. With infants, this involves feeding, changing, holding and comforting them. For toddlers, this may include toilet training and assisting with personal hygiene, like washing hands.

The competition comprises of 3 activities over 1 hour 50 minutes, based on child development.

Live competition heats will be held at various venues across Wales.

### **Entry Criteria**

The competition is for those training for a career in Childcare and studying towards a Level 1 qualification with a recognised Additional Learning Need. Please ensure your entrants have the skills and competencies to complete the task.

### **Entry capacity restrictions by organisation**

Maximum of up to 2 per location plus maximum of 2 reserves can be registered in case of absence.

This is the maximum number of entries permitted by an organisation for this competition. This is determined by 'location' and 'organisation'. 'Organisation' refers to the competitors' training provider/employer. 'Location' refers to a site where the competitor studies / is employed.

This competition may be subject to a selection process if competitor registration numbers

exceed the host venue capacity. Where capacity is identified in a competition the reserve competitors may be invited to compete.

The decision will be made following a consultation between Skills Competition Wales and the competition lead after registration closes. All parties will be notified of any changes.

## **Brief**

Competitors will have 10 minutes introduction to the environment to ask questions then a further 1 hour and 50 minutes to complete all three activities

### **Activity 1: Change a baby's nappy**

Individual task: up to 30 minutes

A newborn baby needs to have their nappy changed between 10 and 12 times a day. You have been asked to demonstrate how to change a dirty nappy (using a doll) following [NHS guidelines](#).

You will be expected to:

- Choose all equipment needed
- Put on PPE
- Change the nappy
- Place the baby in a secure area
- Dispose of the nappy appropriately.
- Clean down the changing area.
- Wash hands following [NHS guidelines](#) .

You will be judged on health and safety and interaction with the baby and the use of incidental Welsh during the activity

### **Activity 2: Nutrition and Hydration activity. Choose and prepare an appropriate snack and drink for a two year old.**

Individual task: up to 20 minutes

You have been asked to prepare a snack (food and drink) for a two year old child. The parents have advised you that the child has a lactose intolerance. Good hygiene is very important. A food and drink selection will be provided at each host venue.

You will need to:

- Collect equipment needed
- Wash hands.
- Take care to follow Welsh [Government guidelines](#) on nutrition and hydration for children
- Prepare items for the child
- Clean area

You will be judged on Health & safety and the appropriate items choices.

### **Activity 3: Plan and make a sensory musical instrument from recycled materials for an 18-month-old child.**

Individual task: up to 60 minutes

You have been asked to make a musical instrument to use with a young child. Think about their senses of touch, sight and sound. You will be provided with a range of recycled/junk materials to create your instrument. You will need to answer questions (written or with Q&A) about the choices you make, it's safety and if it's appropriate for age and stage of development.

You will need to:

- Choose appropriate resources
- Create a musical instrument
- Clear up your work space
- Explain why you made your choices

You will be judged on health and safety and links to development

### **Trosolwg o'r Gystadleuaeth**

Mae cynorthwydd gofal plant fel arfer yn ymwneud â gofal corfforol plant. Gyda babanod, mae hyn yn golygu eu bwydo, eu newid, eu dal a'u cysuro. Ar gyfer plant bach, gall hyn gynnwys eu dysgu i fynd i'r tŷ bach a chynorthwyo gyda hylendid personol, fel golchi dwylo.

Bydd y gystadleuaeth yn cynnwys 3 gweithgaredd dros 1 awr 50 munud, yn seiliedig ar ddatblygiad plant.

Cynhelir rowndiau rhagbrofol byw mewn sawl lleoliad ledled Cymru.

### **Gweithgaredd 1: Newid cewyn babi**

Tasg unigol: hyd at 30 munud

Mae angen newid cewyn babi newydd-anedig rhwng 10 a 12 gwaith y dydd.

Gofynnir i chi ddangos sut i newid cewyn budr (gan ddefnyddio dol) yn dilyn [canllawiau'r GIG](#).

Bydd disgwyl i chi:

- Ddewis yr holl offer sydd ei angen
- Gwisgo cyfarpar diogelu personol (PPE)
- Newid y cewyn
- Rhoi'r babi mewn man diogel
- Cael gwared â'r cewyn mewn ffordd addas.
- Glanhau'r man newid.
- Golchi eich dwylo gan ddilyn [Canllawiau'r GIG](#).

Byddwch yn cael eich beirniadu ar iechyd a diogelwch a rhyngweithio gyda'r babi a defnydd o Gymraeg achlysurol yn ystod y gweithgaredd

### **Gweithgaredd 2: Gweithgaredd Maeth a Hydradu (*Hydration*).**

Dewiswch ac ewch ati i baratoi byrbryd a diod priodol ar gyfer plentyn dwy flwydd oed. Tasg unigol: hyd at 20 munud

Rydych wedi cael eich gofyn i baratoi byrbryd (bwyd a diod) ar gyfer plentyn dwy flwydd oed. Mae'r rhieni wedi eich cynghori bod gan y plentyn anoddefiad lactos (*lactose intolerance*). Mae hylendid da yn bwysig iawn. Bydd dewis o fwyd a diod ar gael ym mhob lleoliad cystadlu.

Tasg unigol: hyd at 60 munud

Gofynnir i chi wneud offeryn cerdd i'w ddefnyddio gyda phlentyn ifanc. Meddyliwch am eu synhwyrau cyffwrdd, golwg a sain. Rhoddir amrywiaeth o ddeunyddiau wedi'u hailgylchu/hen bethau i chi i greu eich offeryn. Bydd angen i chi ateb cwestiynau (ysgrifenedig neu ar ffurf cwestiwn ac ateb) am y dewisiadau a wnewch - ei ddiogelwch, a yw'n briodol ar gyfer yr oedran a chyfnod datblygu.

Bydd angen i chi:

- Ddewis adnoddau priodol
- Creu offeryn cerdd
- clirio eich man gwaith
- esbonio pam y gwnaethoch eich dewisiadau

Cewch eich beirniadu yn seiliedig ar iechyd a diogelwch a chyswllt â datblygiad
