Competition Title

Plumbing and Heating

Competition Overview

A Plumber is an essential member of the construction team. They specialise in installation and maintenance of systems used for hot and cold water, heating and sanitation.

In this competition, competitors will be given an installation task, with which they must demonstrate their ability to interpret the drawing, work accurately and within the timescales given.

Live competition heats will be held at various venues across Wales.

Entry Criteria

The competition is for those training for a career in the Construction Industry and studying towards but not yet achieved a Level 3 qualification or apprenticeship.

Please ensure that your entrants have the skills and competences to complete the task.

Entry capacity restrictions by organisation

Maximum of up to 2 per location plus maximum of 2 reserves can be registered in case of absence.

This is the maximum number of entries permitted by an organisation for this competition.

This is determined by 'location' and 'organisation'. 'Organisation' refers to the competitors' training provider/employer. 'Location' refers to a site where the competitor studies / is employed. For further guidance on these capacities, click here

Task Duration

5 Hours

Brief

Competitors will be given a drawing, from which they are to carry out an installation task; thereby showing they are able to interpret



the drawing, accurately mark out, fabricate and install pipe work, whilst working accurately and to a strict time-scale.

Competitors will be assessed on the following criteria:

- Working safely
- Interpreting drawings and pipe details
- Measuring, fitting and installation requirements
- Measuring, marking out and cutting copper & plastic pipe work
- Bend and joint quality
- Plumb & level
- Testing pipe work for soundness
- Efficient use of materials

Infrastructure List

Competitors are expected to bring their own tools. Benches will be available at the venue.

Generic competition rules

- Mobile phones are to be switched off during competition activity.
- Listening to music via headphones is not permitted during competition activity.
- Any questions during competition activity should be addressed to the competition judging panel.
- Competitors should not communicate with other competitors during competition activity.
- It is the responsibility of each competitor to arrive on time for each competition session. No additional time will be allowed if you arrive late.
- Technical failure of your equipment should be reported immediately to the judging panel. Additional time will be allocated if the fault is beyond the control of the competitor.
- To increase your chances and the accuracy of your work, we suggest you use a digital angle finder/folding rule and digital level.
- No pre-made templates to be brought into the competition, however graph paper and/or lining paper may be used on the day.
- Please bring your own set of hand tools and pipe bending equipment.
- 2 marks will be deducted for every socket used.
- 2 marks will be deducted for every extra length of pipe used
- Pressure testing will be carried out with the assistance of a judge once you have completed the task.

Marking and Assessment

Marking and judging of this competition will be carried out by a team of experts from Industry, Further Education or Training Provider, using a marking criteria and allocated marks to ensure consistency.

Brief breakdown of marking and assessment

All marks are objective and will be awarded by the judges as follows
