## Competition Brief

### Competition title and level

Construction Metalwork

### Entry requirements

The competition is intended for students, apprentices studying towards a level 3 Welding qualification.

### Competition outline

**Stage One:** Internal qualifying/ selection process with partner institutions.

**Stage Two: Competitors to register online by 20<sup>th</sup> October 2018**

**Stage Three:** Partner institutions will be informed of their place allocation depending on applications.

**Stage Four:** The Wales Final hosted at Coleg Gwent, Newport on Wednesday the 23rd January 2019.

### The detail

The Wales final will require the fabrication of a support stand. Skills tested will include.

- MAGS Welding
- Drilling
- Sawing
- Oxy-acetylene cutting (Thermally cut edges should not be dressed)
- Assembly methods
- Marking out

All welds will be visually inspected only. All fabrications will be inspected for accuracy, quality of finish and presentation.

### Marking and assessment

Each aspect of the fabrication will judges against a detailed marking scheme

- All competitors will receive a health and safety briefing at the start of the competition and these rules must be adhered to throughout the competition
- Competitors who arrive late for competitions will not normally receive additional time.
- Competitors will start and finish work as instructed by the judges.
- During the competition competitors should not disturb other competitors or speak to members of the public.
- Any competitor who wishes to leave the area during the competition must seek the permission of the judges.
- Competitors will not be allowed contact with tutors/coaches during the live competition. Non-compliance with this may result in deduction of points.
- If there is a power stoppage or accident, the competitors must act according to the instructions of the judges
- Competitors who break or damage equipment during the competition will not receive any additional time.
- Where a competitor is observed working in an unsafe manner they will be stopped and not permitted to continue unless willing to follow the judges' directions.
- The competition will be assessed and marked by a panel of judges (from industry, colleges or training providers) using the competition criteria and allocation of marks.
