

Digital Video Competition 2019

Level 2/3

Entry requirements

This competition is aimed at students who are studying a Level 2 or 3 FE course. Groups of up to five who are following a moving image or media related programme of study may enter. Please note that this is a Skills Competition Wales event, the winner does not get automatic entry to WorldSkills UK and will have to re-register to compete regionally at a separate qualifying event. Please note that a maximum of one group may enter per FE organisation.

Competition Brief

The scope of the competition enables learners to develop and demonstrate a variety of creative, technical and vocational skills that are essential within the contemporary creative media industries. The competition has an open brief – teams may enter moving image work such as:

- Short Fiction
- Short Factual
- Animation
- Motion Graphics
- Music Video
- Promotional Video

The Detail

Work should not exceed 10 minutes in duration. You will need to screen your project to a panel of industry judges alongside an audience of fellow competitors: following your screening, you should make a presentation (maximum) of five minutes duration outlining the following:

- Your project aims and objectives
- How you managed your project
- Your production process in terms of creativity and technique

Finally you will be required to answer questions from the judging panel about your project. You may also submit any supporting production documentation, research and preparatory work to the judges for their consideration at the end of the presentation session. The presentation will take place at the **Pontio Arts Centre, Bangor, on Tuesday January 22nd 2019** (hosted by Coleg Menai). We ask that the work be presented before the competition on the 18th of January 2019. This will give organisers time to prepare before the day itself.

The work will be shown in the Studio (where the competition will take place), in the main Theatre (between bands, where the Pop Music competition will take place) and on the competition Facebook page www.facebook.com/SgiliauCyfrngauaChreadigol (where work will be released to coincide with competition times).

Due to this we ask that submission content adhere to BBCF **12A** classification

We also ask that any copyrighted material has been cleared prior to submission.


