Competition Brief

Competition Title

Performing Arts

Competition Overview

Performing arts include a range of disciplines which are performed in front of a live audience, including theatre, music, and dance.

In this competition, competitors will have the opportunity to develop and demonstrate a variety of performance skills that are essential within the Performing Arts industries.

Entry Criteria

The competition is for those enrolled on a Performing Arts course studying on a level 2 or 3 qualification.

Entry capacity restrictions by organisation

Maximum of up to 1 team per organisation plus an additional 1 reserve team can be registered in case of absence.

Teams can be made up of 3 to 7 participants.

Brief

The theme this year will be '**INCOMPLETE**'

- You are required to work together to create a performance lasting a **maximum of 10 minutes**. The development of this **must** be learner led.
- You will be required to answer questions by the judging panel about the development of your performance.
- Produce a written log/mindmap of your creative process/development.
- The performance can combine existing text or song with its own work.
- The performance can be a mix of the three disciplines, dance, singing and acting – it can include one or a combination of all of the above.
- Can include opportunities for both ensemble and solo elements.
- Performers must be able to carry any props on and off stage

within the allotted total stage time.

- *A wash lighting state will be provided at the host venue – (*there may not be much time for tech rehearsals prior to the competition on the day*).
- This will take place on Tuesday 23rd January at USW Atrium.
- Total stage time is 25 minutes. Points will be deducted for going over the time allocated. Consideration must also be given to set-up and stage times.

Competition specific rules

The maximum number of teams each organisation may enter is three and teams must be made up of three competitors. The three teams scoring the highest points will be awarded first, second and third prize.

- No questions are allowed to be asked to judges if it is related to the tasks given.
- No material is allowed to be removed from the competition area unless specified
- Work collaboratively and communicate effectively
- Competition will start promptly as advertised. Any team that arrives late will only be able to take part at the judges' discretion.
- Mobile phones are to be switched off during the competition activity.
- Technical failure of equipment should be reported immediately to the judging panel/staff member. Additional time will be allocated if the fault is beyond the control of the competitor.

- Mae'n ofynnol i chi gydweithio i greu perfformiad sy'n para **hyd at 10 munud a dim mwy**. Rhaid i'r dasg o ddatblygu hwn gael ei arwain gan y dysgwr.
- Gall y perfformiad gyfuno testun neu gân sy'n bodoli eisoes â'ch gwaith eich hun.
- Paratoi cofnod/map meddwl ysgrifenedig o'ch prosesau creadigol/datblygiad creadigol.



- Gall y perfformiad fod yn gymysgedd o'r tair disgyblaeth, sef dawnsio, canu ac actio – gall gynnwys un neu gyfuniad o'r uchod.
- Gall gynnwys cyfleoedd ar gyfer elfennau ensemble ac unigol fel ei gilydd.
- Rhaid i berfformwyr allu cario unrhyw bropiau i ac oddi ar y llwyfan, a hynny o fewn cyfanswm yr amser llwyfan a neilltuwyd.
- *Bydd goleuadau llwyfan yn cael eu darparu yn y lleoliad sy'n cynnal y digwyddiad – (*efallai na fydd llawer iawn o amser ar gyfer ymarferion technegol cyn y gystadleuaeth ar y diwrnod*).
